The Main Storyline

AKA The Reason Every Team Has At Least Two Members Who Live in SF

1 point each:

1. This destination for San Francisco dance and theater counts Micaya and Allan Frias among its instructors and will host the upcoming Mission in the Mix. In front of the mural that adorns this venue's street-facing entrance, teach two 8 counts of choreography to a stranger or strangers.
2. This historic movie theater has had many names since its opening in the early 1900s, including The Poppy, The New 16th Street, and The Rex. In front of the theater, record a video reenacting an iconic movie scene in 10 seconds or less.
3. The walls of this community center feature feminine icons from history and fiction, and the names of more than 600 women in calligraphy. Under the gaze of these great women, take a photo of any female team member carrying a male team member on her back.
4. With a disco ball over the dance floor and a bearskin rug on the wall, the name of this 22nd Street establishment is sure to raise eyebrows with first timers. In or around this dive bar, show us a 10 second sketch of two or more team members on an awkward first date.
5. Since 1992, this street has been painted with over 700 murals by artists both local and international while playing host to an annual block party. In this public gallery of social inclusivity and civic engagement, snap a photo of life imitating art.
6. Once known as the Madison Square Garden of the West, the interior of this San Francisco landmark has featured in The Empire Strikes Back, as well as a number of BDSM productions. Against this building's brick facade, show us what the team would look like if cast in a video where, in the words of the poet Rihanna, "chains and whips excite [you]".
7. Born right here in the Mission, the Valencia Street location of this small batch chocolate maker is a factory, retail shop, and cafe all at once. Show us a team member's reaction to a sample of 100% chocolate.

8. This tiny, boutique bowling alley is about as San Francisco as it gets - six lanes, hidden away on a side street, featuring a brunch menu and full bar. Outside the venue, record a video of a strike with one team member as the ball... And the others as pins.
9. Peeping into a hole you find in an alley can have mixed results, but doing so at this particular location reveals a stream of short films and animations that play 24/7. Show us the team at the peephole looking like they just saw something scandalous.
10. During the fires that followed the San Francisco earthquake of 1906, the city's single functioning fire hydrant saved the Mission from a fiery doom and was painted gold in recognition of its efforts. Take a photo or video of the team acting like the paparazzi around this deserving local celebrity.

Extra Credit

AKA The Real Treasure Was The Friends We Made Along The Way

1 point each:

1. Take a photo with an unusual mode of transportation.
2. Record a stranger telling you their favorite thing about the Mission in 30 seconds or less.
3. Take a photo of any item with Game of Thrones branding or a Game of Thrones reference.
4. Record the team dancing to any music played by a street performer, store or restaurant.
5. Take a photo with a stranger who has great personal style.

PS: If you do dance to music played by a street performer, consider leaving them a tip as thanks!
